

SOMERVILLE YMCA RESIDENTS POLICY

GENERAL INFORMATION:

This is your home away from home where cleanliness, thoughtfulness and consideration for others and the customs of good Christian living are stressed. Below you will find a list of rules and regulations to make your stay here more enjoyable. These regulations are set up for your own protection and to create and maintain the type of home in which you would like to live.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. **Dormitory men must be members** of this Association.
2. Residence in the YMCA **does not establish** a relationship of landlord and tenant. Residence is a privilege and the right to withdraw it at any time is reserved.
3. A \$10.00 deposit on keys will be refunded if room rent is paid and keys are turned in.
4. Room rents must be paid a week in advance.
5. One week's notice must be given by occupant before the room is vacated.
6. Quiet hours are from 10:30 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. Residents will refrain from loud talking in the corridors, etc. Radios, musical instruments, singing or any disturbing noise must cease at 10:30 p.m.
7. Intoxicating liquors and gambling is forbidden.
8. Washing clothes is not permitted in the building.
9. Familiarize yourself with the exits-besides the main stairway, there are exits leading over the roof. (for emergency use only.)
10. **NO COOKING** in your room; **NO UNAUTHORIZED ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES ALLOWED.**
11. Rooms will be used only by person renting it.
12. **NO VISITORS** allowed in dormitories.
13. The Association will not be responsible for loss to residents' property by theft, fire or other cause. All are urged to lock their rooms.
14. Turn lights off and close windows when you leave your room.
15. Placing any objects on window sills or throwing objects out of window is strictly forbidden
16. Any man who does not comply with the above listed residents' policies may have his resident privileges withdrawn.
17. If you have any personal or financial problems, feel free to see the YMCA controller or the Executive Director at any time.

These rules are intended to protect the personal safety and liberty of all and to abridge the rights of none.
